



Security Council Briefing on 2140 Committee 05 November 2025

Greece's Remarks delivered by H.E. Ambassador Aglaia Balta, Permanent Representative of Greece to the United Nations, New York

Mr. President,

I would like to thank Ambassador Sangjin Kim for his briefing and for his dedicated work as the Chair of the 2140 Sanctions Committee.

Greece commends the Republic of Korea for its leadership in advancing the Committee's efforts toward the implementation of Security Council resolution 2140(2014) and subsequent resolutions reinforcing the sanctions regime established, including 2216(2015) and 2624(2022). We also reiterate the importance of the 2140 Committee's Panel of Experts and commend its most recent report.

The Houthis continue to consolidate their strength, posing a persistent and growing threat to the Yemeni people and to the stability of the broader region, including the Red Sea.

Against this backdrop, the Committee plays an indispensable role in advancing full respect of the sanctions regime, in a comprehensive and systematic manner, especially toward the effective implementation of the targeted arms embargo and prevention of illicit transfers of weaponry to the Houthis.

Greece reaffirms its support for advancing the Committee's role in ensuring the full implementation of its mandate.
